Application Process

To ensure that your application is complete, follow each step below and include all of the required items in your application packet. ***Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.***

- STEP 1:** Review the eligibility requirements for the NCC Foundation Bigelow Scholarship.

Eligible students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current senior at a public high school in Norwalk, Connecticut
- Be in good academic standing and not on probationary status
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident

- STEP 2:** Complete the NCC Foundation 2018-2019 Bigelow Scholarship Application. If a question does not apply to you, please write "N/A" in the space provided.

- STEP 3:** Provide a copy of your high school transcript with cumulative GPA.

- STEP 4:** Submit a letter of reference from a guidance counselor or principal. **Letters from anyone other than a guidance counselor or principal will not be accepted.** Include contact information (address, phone and email) of the guidance counselor or principal.

- STEP 5:** Make sure you have a **COMPLETED 2018-2019** FAFSA on file with the NCC Financial Aid office. This must be completed and received by the Financial Aid office by **4 pm on June 5, 2018.**

Things to keep in mind:

- Students who are awarded scholarships will be expected to write a thank you letter to the NCC Foundation and to be available to meet with the scholarship donors if requested.
- The FAFSA can take a few days to be transmitted to the Financial Aid Office. Make sure you start it early and put in the correct school code for NCC. The NCC School code is **001399**.
- Students who are awarded the Bigelow Scholarship for 2018-2019 will automatically be considered for 2018-2019 scholarship funds, pending successful completion of all courses resulting in a 2.0 GPA or better. Based on successful academic performance, this award can be renewed for a second year at NCC.
