

## 2023-2024 Charles Royce Merit Scholarship

### Application deadline is Friday, June 2, 2023

All materials must be submitted to the NCC Foundation via email at [scholarships@norwalk.edu](mailto:scholarships@norwalk.edu).  
Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

To ensure that your application is complete, make sure to complete each step below:

1. Review the eligibility requirements for the Charles Royce Merit Scholarship. You must:
  - Be a current senior at a public high school in southwestern Fairfield County
  - Possess a **minimum 2.8** cumulative High School GPA
  - Be in good academic standing and not on probationary status
2. Complete the 2023-2024 Royce Merit Scholarship Application and return via email to [scholarships@norwalk.edu](mailto:scholarships@norwalk.edu). If a question does not apply to you, please write “N/A” in the space provided.
3. Provide a copy of your high school transcript. **ONLY** numerical GPAs will be accepted – not letter grades.
4. A letter of recommendation from a principal, guidance counselor, or faculty member is required and should be sent directly to the NCC Foundation. Please ask your recommender to place your name in the subject line and include their phone and email.
5. This scholarship is open to all. If you are a US citizen or permanent resident, please have a **COMPLETED** 2023-2024 FAFSA on file with the NCC Financial Aid office by **the application due date**.

#### **Things to keep in mind:**

- ❖ The FAFSA can take a few days to be transmitted to the Financial Aid Office. Make sure you start it early. The NCC School code is **007635**.
- ❖ Students who are awarded scholarships will be expected to write a thank you letter to the donor and be available to meet them if requested.
- ❖ Students who are awarded the Royce Merit Scholarship for 2022-2023 will automatically be considered for 2023-2024 scholarship funds, pending successful completion of all courses resulting in a 2.5 GPA or better. Based on successful academic performance, this award can be renewed for a second year at NCC.
